## District Moves on Healthcare

On Thursday, Oct. 26, the district made a proposal to fund our healthcare for the next three years. This is significant movement off their original plan to gut our healthcare, and it is a result of our organizing for collective actions and growing solidarity with our labor partners. But this is not enough.

Our fight for healthcare continues on Nov. 16, when we are back at the healthcare bargaining table. We will continue fighting for increased district contributions to protect our healthcare reserves and cover cost increases in future years.

The district has not made any significant proposals on key issues relating to salary, lower class size, overtesting, increase in per-pupil funding, and more nurses, counselors, and teacher librarians. Our fight is for a sustainable school system that attracts students, retains educators and pushes back on privatization.

We must show the district our strength and solidarity by mass participation in our regional rallies on Nov. 16!
