SUMMARY OF TALKING POINTS TO SHARE WITH UTLA MEMBERS ON THE STATUS OF BARGAINING:

- 18 Sessions No movement from LAUSD on anything
- Salary: UTLA proposing 20% over 2 years, LAUSD proposing 8% over 2 years
- Class Size and Staffing: LAUSD rejects our proposals and offers no serious solution
- LAUSD declares a reserve of \$4.9 billion in official report
- Of that, \$3.18 billion is completely unrestricted
- Law requires school districts to hold 2% in reserve. \$3.18 billion is 32%!
- Sitting on \$3.18 billion in unrestricted reserves is not fiscal responsibility it is fiscal neglect of our students. Carvalho is choosing to hoard this money while students and educators suffer.

CHAPTER LEADER ACTION STEPS

1. BEFORE MARCH 1: SIGN UP EVERY SINGLE MEMBER TO JOIN THE MARCH 15 RALLY AT GRAND PARK IN FRONT OF CITY HALL!

- Work with your Chapter Action Team to talk to every member at your school or chapter so that they know the importance of demonstrating the power of a supermajority at the rally.
- Get every member in your chapter to sign the rally commitment petition.
- You can make an announcement at the Faculty Meeting and pass a clipboard around and also discuss it in more detail in your Chapter Meeting.

- Report progress to your cluster leader.

2. TUESDAY, JANUARY 24: STICKER UP ON RED SHIRT TUESDAY!

- Notify your Chapter and Chapter Action Team of the plan to demonstrate unity through a sticker action on January 24 and wearing red. Develop a plan to distribute the stickers, one on one or in a group.
- Don't just leave the stickers in the mailboxes! You will need to explain why the action is important and get a commitment to wear it.
- Use your CHAPTER ROSTER to make sure everyone is given a sticker and to track who is wearing it.
- Use the Faculty Meeting! If your school is having a faculty meeting on Tuesday, January 24, use it to send a message to LAUSD that you are all united. Your principal will have to report that everyone on your staff was wearing the sticker.
