BEYOND RECOVERY CONTRACT CAMPAIGN

JANUARY 18 - MARCH 1

SUMMARY OF TALKING POINTS TO SHARE WITH UTLA MEMBERS ON THE STATUS OF BARGAINING:

- 18 Sessions – No movement from LAUSD on anything
- Salary: UTLA proposing 20% over 2 years, LAUSD proposing 8% over 2 years
- Class Size and Staffing: LAUSD rejects our proposals and offers no serious solution
- LAUSD declares a reserve of \$4.9 billion in official report
- Of that, \$3.18 billion is completely unrestricted
- Law requires school districts to hold 2% in reserve. \$3.18 billion is 32%!
- Sitting on \$3.18 billion in unrestricted reserves is not fiscal responsibility – it is fiscal neglect of our students. Carvalho is choosing to hoard this money while students and educators suffer.

- Expand Community Schools and provide resources for family/community/youth engagement and wrap-around services
