#### There are 7 Voting Members of the School Board.

They are elected by voters in seven districts across LAUSD. Every single voter in Los Angeles can vote in School Board elections within their particular district, regardless of whether they have a connection to LAUSD.

#### 3 or 4 seats are up for election every two years.

They alternate between odd and even number districts. School Board Districts 2, 4, and 6 were up for election in 2022. In 2024, it will be Districts 1, 3, 5, 7.

#### LAUSD is the second-largest school district in the country.

LAUSD is also the second-largest government body in the LA Area. It has a budget larger than the City and is one of the largest landowners in LA. What happens in LAUSD can be felt across the country.

# The School Board makes big-picture decisions and sets policies for the school district.

For example, they approve the budget, set the curriculum, and decide the general direction of the district. The superintendent is hired by the School Board to manage the day-to-day operations of the district.


