Submit a video no longer than 5 minutes that includes:

1 Understanding of Ruben Salazar's Legacy

- Who was he? What was his work as a journalist?
- What happened during the Chicano Moratorium?

2 Impact on Your Community Today

- How does his legacy still matter?
- What issues Salazar fought for are present now?

3 Personal Story & Current Advocacy

- Share a meaningful moment that connects you to Salazar's fight for truth and representation.
- How are you contributing to your school, family, or community?

4 Future Commitment

- How will you continue his legacy in college and your career?

5 Authenticity & Verification

Your submission must include:

- You speaking directly in the video (your voice and/or face visible for part of the video)
- A 150–200 word written reflection submitted separately:

“Why is Ruben Salazar’s story personally meaningful to you, and how did you approach creating this project?”

- Any creative featured content must be your original work
- Signed originality statement (form provided)
