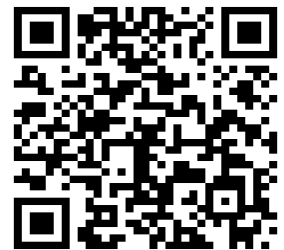


✓ SIGN UP TO WALK
