Memorandum of Understanding

Los Angeles Unified School District and United Teachers Los Angeles Use of Technology to Support Instruction

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to memorialize an agreement between the Los Angeles Unified School District and United Teachers Los Angeles regarding the use of technology to support instruction within TK-12 schools.

- 1.0 The District and UTLA acknowledge that advancements in technology including the use of generative artificial intelligence (AI) within the educational environment is a fast-growing initiative designed to support student achievement and improve equity and access for student learners. In planning for these advancements, the District shall establish a collaborative task force to review and provide input regarding the use of generative AI within the instructional setting. UTLA will serve as a stakeholder group on this task force with up to (3) representatives appointed by UTLA. The taskforce will meet at least once each semester for the term of this Agreement.
- 2.0 If the District seeks to use a generative AI application with reasonably foreseeable impacts on UTLA's bargaining unit members terms and conditions of employment, if any, the district will provide notice to UTLA for the purposes of affording an opportunity to demand to meet and confer in alignment with the district's appropriate obligations under EERA.
- 3.0 <u>In support of the instructional program, the District shall make every reasonable effort to provide appropriate wi-fi at all TK-12 school campuses.</u>
- 4.0 <u>Teachers will utilize and integrate technology, as appropriate, within the instructional program.</u>
- 5.0 <u>Based on available funding, the District may provide drop-in technology support</u> for students and families at each region office and/or identified location within a regional area.

This MOU is non-precedent setting and will remain in effect for the duration of the parties 2025-2028 LAUSD/UTLA Collective Bargaining Agreement.
