As the Trump administration’s ICE raids escalated this summer across LA neighborhoods, in clinics, workplaces, and places of worship, the district has so far failed to move with any urgency to support and protect LAUSD students, families, and staff heading into the new school year.

A Sanctuary Team is a team of all interest holders that are part of your school community, who will enforce district sanctuary and safe school policy, enforce safety plans, build a safe passage to help monitor immigration enforcement in the community and at the school site, and communicate with the school community and UTLA to initiate the Rapid Response network.

Sanctuary Team Members will:

- Meet regularly with the Chapter Chair and fellow Sanctuary Team members.
- Create and implement safety plan in collaboration with your Local School Leadership Council (LSLC).
- Mobilize co-workers and community members to take action in support of the immigrant community to protect and defend public education.
- Create safe passage for all students.
- Build a relationship with community partners.
