How to Win in Bargaining By Getting Strike Ready

LESSON OBJECTIVES

- 1. Understand how collective action drives this fight and what steps we must take next to win.
- 2. Deliver bargaining and healthcare updates that recognize the district's delays and refusal to invest in our schools, where they are stuck, and why.
- 3. UTLA members affirm they will vote yes to authorize a strike if LAUSD does not settle the contract by January.
