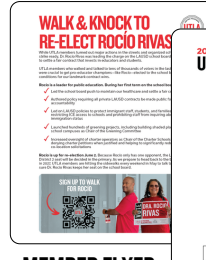

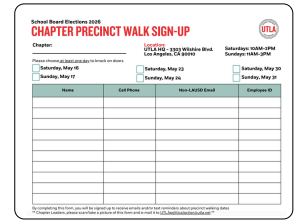
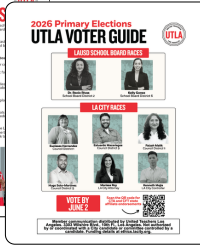
I. RE-ELECT DR. ROCÍO RIVAS

MEMBER FLYER WITH VOTER GUIDE

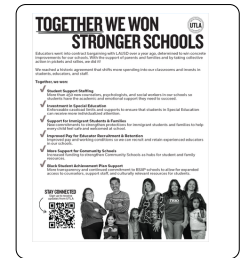


PRECINCT WALK SIGNUP

3. FILL OUT THE NOTICE OF CHAPTER CHAIR ELECTION FORM

- If you self-nominated for Chapter Chair for next school year and there were no other self-nominations, you should have been notified via email. If you have not filled out the Notice of Chapter Chair Election (NOCCE) form, do so as soon as possible.
- If no one at your site filled out the self-nomination form by the deadline, the first person to fill out the NOCCE form will be the Chapter Chair for 2026-2027.

UTLA ENDORSEMENTS

The election for Dr. Rocío Rivas for LAUSD School Board District 2 is here. Ballots have arrived in voters' mailboxes and voting has begun.

→ WHY SCHOOL BOARD SEATS MATTER

Today our influence on the school board is significantly different due to our work to win school board elections. We have elected champions like Rocío Rivas and Karla Griego, who will always fight for UTLA values.

Rocío Rivas has been our strongest champion on the school board and we need to do all we can to re-elect her.

Because Rocío only has one opponent, this school board election will be decided on June 2, so it is critical we talk to voters to encourage them to re-elect Rocío Rivas.

Polling consistently shows that voters trust and respect educators and UTLA – this means voters are likely to vote for Rocío Rivas if a UTLA member asks them to vote for the UTLA-endorsed candidate.

→ ROCÍO & CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS

Examples of some questions to engage members during the meeting:

- Who here, by a show of hands, is glad that we got the salary increase without going on strike?
- Who here is proud of our agreement that increases the number of counselors, PSAs, and PSWs? What about the 4 weeks of paid parental leave we won? And so much more?
- Why do you think that we didn't have to go on strike to win this historic settlement?

Rocío's leadership on the inside helped us reach a contract victory without a strike.

Rocío challenged her colleagues on the board and the district's austerity approach, urging the district to invest in students and educators.

We will be back at the bargaining table in 2027 and we need to make sure we re-elect a proven ally, our school board champion Rocío Rivas.

→ SIGN UP TO WALK FOR ROCÍO

We can't afford to risk losing our influence on the school board, especially with bargaining starting up again next year. So we need to do our part to talk to voters and get them to vote to re-elect Rocío Rivas.
