

WALK & KNOCK TO RE-ELECT ROCÍO RIVAS



While UTLA members turned out major actions in the streets and organized school sites to get strike ready, Dr. Rocío Rivas was leading the charge on the LAUSD school board to push the district to settle a fair contract that invests in educators and students.

UTLA members who walked and talked to tens of thousands of voters in the last two election cycles were crucial to get pro-educator champions—like Rocío—elected to the school board, setting the conditions for our landmark contract wins.

Rocío is a leader for public education. During her first term on the school board, she:

- ✓ Led the school board push to maintain our healthcare and settle a fair contract
- ✓ Authored policy requiring all private LAUSD contracts be made public for more accountability
- ✓ Led on LAUSD policies to protect immigrant staff, students, and families, including restricting ICE access to schools and prohibiting staff from inquiring about immigration status
- ✓ Launched hundreds of greening projects, including building shaded play areas on school campuses as Chair of the Greening Committee
- ✓ Increased oversight of charter operators as Chair of the Charter Schools Committee, denying charter petitions when justified and helping to significantly reduce charter co-location solicitations

Rocío is up for re-election June 2. Because Rocío only has one opponent, the LAUSD Board District 2 seat will be decided in the primary. As we prepare to head back to the bargaining table in 2027, UTLA members are hitting the sidewalks every weekend in May to talk to voters and make sure Dr. Rocío Rivas keeps her seat on the school board.
